

2008 – 2009 Event Description

Taste of Asia: Host of the event selects and reserves seats at a restaurant and prepares a brief presentation that introduces the cuisine, customs and basic words of the culture that related to the selected restaurant. Participants contribute equally to the cost of the food.

Movie Club: Host of the event selects a movie to be played at a pre-selected location and briefly introduces the cultural context, and background of the movie. After the movie, participants discuss about the movie.

Recreational Sports Club: Host of the event selects a sport and reserves a location. Participants engage in friendly competition in a relax setting. Example of recreational sports: Ping Pong, Badminton, Mahjong, etc.

Cooking Club: Host of the event demonstrates the process of making a few dishes with the help of all participants. At the end of the session, all the participants enjoy the dishes together and contribute equally to the cost of the food.

World Fest: World Fest is the yearly community-building event from AIS. Families from AIS as well as the nearby communities enjoy cuisine and many other activities at the AIS campus. Asian Culture Club will support the organization of the event to showcase Asian cultures and cuisine.

Asian New Year celebration: Asian Cultural Club's signature event. The Asian New Year follows the lunar calendar and is celebrated by Chinese, Koreans, Mongolians, Nepalese, Bhutanese, and Vietnamese and by ethnic Chinese in Philippines, Malaysia, Singapore, etc. Participants enjoy Asian cuisine, watch lion dance and performances from the AIS students and outside performers.

Asian Festival celebration: Hosted by the Asian Culture Club, participants celebrate a traditional festival from an Asian country; enjoy ethnic food and take part in festive activities. Example:

- Moon Festival celebration 2007 – Moon Festival is a Chinese Festival that celebrates the reunion of family. Participants gathered at the Mandarin classroom, sampled moon cake, drink Chinese tea, read poems and guessed riddles.
